ARE YOU LOOKING FOR WAYS TO GO GREEN?

Now you can support clean energy by signing up for Duke Energy's GoGreen program. The new GoGreen program was created through the collaborative work of the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel, Duke Energy and others to bring more options to consumers who are seeking ways to support alternatives to traditionally produced electricity.

WHAT IS THE GOGREEN PROGRAM?

This program gives customers the option to purchase renewable energy certificates (RECs) which support the development of renewable energy. By signing up for the GoGreen program and supporting clean energy, you will pay as little as \$5 to purchase a minimum of 200 kilowatt hours (kWh) of RECs each month. WHAT ARE RENEWABLE ENERGY CERTIFICATES?

Renewable energy certificates represent the positive environmental and social attributes associated with renewable energy resources. By purchasing RECs, in addition to any energy efficiency measures you are already practicing, you can further reduce the environmental impact that is left by your daily activities.

HOW DOES THE DUKE GOGREEN PROGRAM HELP CONSUMERS?

It is important to have many different energy options available to help minimize future price increases associated with fossil fuels like coal or natural gas. Supporting the development of renewable energy by signing up for the GoGreen program stimulates the market to expand renewable energy resources that will improve the environment and help control costs over time.



HOW DOES RENEWABLE ENERGY HELP THE ENVIRONMENT?

Renewable energy, like wind, solar or biomass power, does not emit any harmful emissions into the atmosphere. It also does not deplete non-renewable resources like coal or natural gas. As more renewable energy is developed in the United States, your support through the purchase of renewable energy certificates will be more helpful to the environment and would likely lower the price for renewable energy in the future.
